**ORDER SETTING THE CONDITIONS OF RELEASE**

Upon consideration of Defendant Walter Anderson's Motion for Release with conditions, the government's opposition, the pleadings and oral arguments presented, it is:

ORDERED that the Motion be and hereby is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that Mr. Anderson will be released from detention upon the following conditions:

(1) that he shall not commit any offense in violation of federal, state, or local law while on release in this case;

(2) that he shall immediately advise the Court, defense counsel, and the attorneys for the government in writing before any change in address and telephone number;

(3) that he shall appear at all proceedings as required;

(4) that he shall report on a regular basis to the District of Columbia Pretrial Services Agency and that he shall comply with all reasonable requests made by that agency;

(5) that he shall surrender all passports and travel documents that have not otherwise been seized by the government;

(6) that he will not seek from any agency or private entity any travel document of any kind (including but not limited to passports, visas, transportation tickets, or driver's licenses);

(7) that he will be restricted to travel only in Washington, D.C. (excluding any interstate train or bus station) unless otherwise permitted with special order of the Court;

(8) that he comply with the District of Columbia Pretrial Services Agency in establishing and maintaining a monitoring system (e.g., daily telephone calls, or visits, or electronic monitoring if feasible) agreed upon by that office and his counsel;

(9) that he provide a general waiver of extradition and a general request to any country to waive their own objections to extradition; and

(10) that he not make contact with any potential government witness in this case except those who are his friends, family or existing business partners or associates; and it is further

ORDERED that as an additional condition of his release, Mr. Anderson's parents will post their home in Annandale, Virginia, which is valued at approximately \$500,000, as security for their son's release.
